***We believe our nation has a purpose and destiny
that is only possible through Jesus Christ
and that the time is now!***

**Call the Nation to Prayer, (CTNTP), is an invitation
to everyone who recognises that this is the time for us
as a nation to turn to God in prayer, to call out to Him for
salvation and healing and a transformation of the United Kingdom**

**We believe this is a directive from the Lord:
a move of prayer for every village, town and city of the UK,
called, initiated and orchestrated by the Holy Spirit**

**We sense that God is asking his church in the UK
to initially respond to this call to prayer in three ways:**

Walk the Nation in prayer

*As preparation for what the Lord is going to do, with all who are willing,
to increasingly leave our buildings and in prayer, walk our streets,
communities and countryside, together soaking the whole land of the UK in prayer.*

Release a 'heavenly sound' that resonates over the UK

*As we prayer walk, to release a joyful sound of praise, worship, blessing
and Godly declaration, which resonates with Heaven over the UK.*

Come together and pray 'As One'

*To come together at a prayer gathering in the centre of the nation,
to be confirmed as, 29th September 2018.*

*We believe God has directed us to a prophetic act of reconciliation and unity,
which will symbolically unite the Word and the Spirit strands of the Christian Faith.
This gathering will be a catalyst for the first two responses.*

We believe that these things form part of the Lord's plan for historical and current prophecies to be fulfilled and for the release of a 'great awakening' for Christ in our land.

Gather others to pray together
Walk alongside us on this journey
Be part of the 'heavenly sound' over the nation

Our Journey

It began on 25th June 2015, when an Englishman called Peter Hill was awoken by the Lord at 1 am in Canada and heard the audible voice of the Lord tell him to, 'call the nation to prayer'.

Peter instinctively knew that the nation was the United Kingdom and that humanly speaking the directive was an impossible task.

However, knowing that everything is possible with God, Peter began a journey towards gathering those in the UK who sensed this call was of God and with whom he sought God's strategy and timing to call the nation to prayer.

In 1971, during the UK Charismatic Renewal, Peter Hill founded the Nationwide Festival of Light which saw tens of thousands of Christians gathered in London. He later emigrated to Canada with his wife, Janet, and now lives in Vernon, British Columbia where he is involved with various evangelistic, business and charitable initiatives.

After receiving the word to call the nation to prayer in 2015, Peter tested it with Christian leaders in Canada and England. Subsequently, in 2016 he made two exploratory visits to England, where he started to renew and establish fresh contacts with UK prayer leaders. During his first visit in April 2016, at Birmingham's World Prayer Centre, Peter met David Gilbey, a retired police officer and leader of a local prayer movement called Chelmsford 24-7 Prayer.

Peter and David teamed up and deepened connections and relationships with prayer movements and others who pray, asking the Lord how He wanted to direct them. It has become increasingly clear as people affirmed Peter and David's vision that God desires a significant move of prayer across the UK and that the time for it is now!

During the Summer of 2017, the Lord provided further direction that CTNTP should involve the people of God in the UK coming together to prayer walk 'the land' - in and around their communities and neighbourhoods, united in purpose and in the Holy Spirit, to soak the nation in prayer.

We have strongly felt that God wants this prayer walking, to involve the creation of 'a joyful heavenly sound' over the nation.

Acting 'As One', God's church united in blessing, prayer, praise, worship, Godly declaration and sharing the gospel as the Spirit leads will be incredibly powerful and reflect Jesus' desire that, 'they may be one, even as we are one' (John 17:11).

Might prayer walking be part of the fulfilment of Jean Darnell's 1967 prophecy, where in a vision of the UK, she first sees 'little pinpricks of light', then that these were fires burning as people prayed, joining up across the nation? Jean then saw 'lightning strike' the fires, (the power of the Holy Spirit) and 'rivers of fire' flow through the UK and outwards to Europe.

Peter Hill visited England again in November 2017 and, with David Gilbey, met praying people as God directed and believed that the next steps for CTNTP were revealed.

Word and Spirit Coming Together

In 1947, Evangelist Smith Wigglesworth prophesied that at a future time in our nation, those whose Christian traditions which emphasise either the Word or the Spirit would start to come together. We can see that in the UK today this is increasingly happening, however divisions do still exist and we believe that the Lord has directed CTNTP to have a part to play in seeing this reconciliation fully realised in God's Church.

The final part of Smith Wigglesworth's Prophecy:

'...When the word and the Spirit come together, there will be the biggest move of the Holy Spirit that the nations, and indeed, the world have ever seen. It will mark the beginning of a revival that will eclipse anything that has been witnessed within these shores, even the Wesleyan and Welsh revivals of former years. The outpouring of God's Spirit will flow over from the United Kingdom to mainland Europe, and from there, will begin a missionary move to the ends of the earth.'

The CTNTP Team strongly sense that the Lord has led us to the centre of England and is leading us to involve a specific prophetic act during a gathering, which we believe will be an initiating factor in the fulfilment of the Prophecy. We have been led to Ezekiel 37:15 onwards, where the binding of two sticks into one represented the union of Israel (Ephraim and Judah).

Without question those in the Church who have held an emphasis on the Word and those who have held an emphasis on the Spirit over many years have had and continue to have a loving shepherding care over the flocks they oversee. The prophetic act will be the joining of two shepherd crooks into one representing the Word and the Spirit strands becoming 'As One'.

Biblical Foundation and Historical Precedence

In times of national crisis God called nations to prayer. A key scripture is 2 Chronicles 20. In the reign of King Jehoshaphat, when threatened by opposing armies, the people of Judah, from every town came together to seek help from the Lord. Jehoshaphat sent men out ahead of his army singing and praising God, (releasing a sound) and God delivered Judah from the hands of her enemies.

Similarly, during World War II with thousands of British soldiers stranded on the beaches of Normandy facing almost certain destruction by the advancing German army, King George VI called the UK to prayer. The result is what we now know as the 'Miracle of Dunkirk' when God intervened in response to prayer and delivered the nation. There are a number of other examples of the UK being called to prayer during both World Wars.

Today, the United Kingdom faces challenges and uncertainties on many fronts, such as issues of sovereignty, immigration, terrorism, and the economy, to our political and social systems.

Yet, we are sure God has a plan to give the UK hope and a future (Jeremiah 29:11), to prosper us and call us as a light to other nations, shining with the light of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that God is calling the UK to national prayer once again at such a time as this.

May we join together 'As One' to pray and see God move again in power in the UK, to restore us in our national identity and calling in Him, to His praise and glory.
